4. Scotsonian funds

- An agreement needs to be reached regarding Scotonians funding/membership. Previously a student would make a refundable deposit to the school when enrolled. This would often be donated to the Scotsonians once year 12 completed and this would grant membership.
- The funds and how they will be managed in the future is still in the process of discussion by the School.
- Albury Grammar account as of December 2017 was \$13,000
- Rosehill Woodstock funds transferred by School to the UCA.
