

## FEE SCHEDULE 2019

### School Fees

The School Fee is an annual fee applicable for all students and encompasses the Net Annual Tuition Fee and the Composite Fee.

### Composite Fee

The School attempts to cover all costs associated with the compulsory curriculum within the Composite Fee. The Composite Fee is charged at all levels and covers the cost in one lump sum of items including: all compulsory whole of year group activities such as class materials, camps, excursions and incursions, insurance, transport costs, instrument hire, ID cards; School magazine together with information technology costs such as internet access, printing allowances and technology resources (for Year K-3).

Students in Year 4-12 are required to provide a suitable device in line with the BYOD Policy specifications at own cost.

The Composite Fee **does not** include the cost of school photographs, elective subjects, optional excursions or co-curricular activities - these are charged separately to School Fees as Additional Charges.

\* Kinder – Year 6 includes all text books and exercise books.

<sup>+</sup> Year 9 includes the Year 9 outdoor education program.

<sup>#</sup> Year 10 excludes camp costs. There are a range of outdoor education programs, careers and work experience options for Year 10 students to participate in and the costs will vary depending on option selected. These costs will be provided at the earliest opportunity and will be added to your account as Additional Charges or paid for via Parent Lounge.

### Boarding Fees

For those students who are boarders the following annual Boarding Fees also apply, and, together with the Net Annual Tuition Fee and Composite Fee they form the total School Fees for boarders.

### Casual Boarding

Day students are able to stay in the boarding house for short term stays. Bookings can be made via the School website.

## Other Fees

### **Application Fee**

A non-refundable application fee of \$150 (includes GST) per student (or \$250 per family when all siblings apply concurrently) is payable on application for admission to the School.

### **Entrance Fee**

A non-refundable entrance fee of \$500 is payable per family on acceptance of an offer of enrolment for the first child entering the School.

### **Additional Charges**

Additional charges for elective subjects, extracurricular tuition (including music lessons, dance and pipe band), optional sports and other activities will be applied to student accounts or paid for via Parent Lounge at the time the Student commences the activity.

### **Voluntary Building Fund (tax deductible)**

This is a voluntary contribution enabling families to support the School's building programme by donating via their family fee billing statement (\$250 on each statement). The School's strategic development plans rely on this contribution. Voluntary Building Fund donations are fully tax deductible with a receipt provided from the school.

## Payment Options

### **Annual in Advance**

Full year's School Fees paid in advance by 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019 (with a discount for early payment as set out in Discounts)

### **Monthly**

10 instalments commencing 15<sup>th</sup> February 2019 (*by direct debit from either a bank account or credit card*)

### **Three Instalments**

Instalment 1 payable on due date 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019

Instalment 2 payable on due date 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019

Instalment 3 payable on due date 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2019

## Payment Methods

All School Fees and other charges are to be paid by cheque; EFTPOS; BPay; credit card (Mastercard, Visa (both of which incur a 0.78% surcharge), American Express (plus 1% surcharge) or Diners Club (plus 3% surcharge)) or direct debit scheme (applicable for those parents who elect the monthly payment option). Cash will not be accepted.

Fees will be charged on a pro-rata basis for new students commencing during a school term. These will be due 14 days from the date of invoice.

## Non-payment of Fees

If the School Fees are not paid within 30 days of the due date, a late payment fee of \$75 will be charged. A further default fee of \$100 will be charged if fees are still owing at 60 days. The School reserves the right to suspend or terminate the enrolment of a student if any portion of the School Fees or other charges remain unpaid.

## Notice of withdrawal

*One term's notice in writing must be given when a student is removed from the School, otherwise a term's fees are payable in lieu.*

## Discounts

### **Annual in Advance**

Where the full annual 2019 School Fees (including Net Annual Tuition Fees, Composite Fee and where applicable Annual Boarding Fees) for each student is paid by 1 March 2019, the family will receive a 4.0% discount on the Net Annual Tuition Fees and where applicable Annual Boarding Fees. No discount is applied to the Composite Fee.

### **Sibling Discounts**

#### **Sibling Discounts on Tuition Fees**

A sibling discount will be applied to the Net Annual Tuition Fees of the second, third or fourth fee paying student from a family where there are siblings simultaneously attending The Scots School Albury.

The Tuition Fee sibling discount is applied in accordance with the following table:

#### **Sibling Discount on Boarding Fees**

A sibling discount will be applied to the Annual Boarding Fees of the second or subsequent fee paying student from the same billing family where there are two or more siblings simultaneously attending The Scots School Albury as Boarders.

The Boarding sibling discount is applied in accordance with the following table:

#### **Notes on Sibling Discounts**

The sibling discount applied to Net Annual Tuition Fees or Annual Boarding Fees will cease to apply at any time when there are less than two children from the same billing family simultaneously attending (and, if applicable, Boarding) at the School and / or where the account(s) are in default.

The sibling discount applied to Net Annual Tuition Fees or Annual Boarding Fees is adjusted on a pro rata basis to reflect any scholarships awarded.

No discount is applied to the Composite Fee (this includes scholarship recipients who will have the applicable scholarship applied only to the Net Annual Tuition Fees or Annual Boarding Fees).
