



2018 Scots HSC Results Unpacked

Highlights

This year, 57 students entered the New South Wales Higher School Certificate across 28 subjects, revealing the extensive academic options available at Scots.

21 students have been included on the Board of Studies Distinguished Achievers List for students who achieve a HSC mark of at least 90/100 (Band 6) for a 2 Unit course or 45/50 (E4) for a 1 Unit course in one or more subjects (8 were acknowledged for more than one subject).

10% (7% 2017) of 2 Unit course results were greater than 90.

44% (40% 2017) of 2 Unit course results were greater than 80.

85% (80% 2017) of 2 Unit course results were greater than 70.
